Rider Course or BRC 2

This Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) sponsored course is designed for riders who have successfully completed a Basic Rider course, riders who possess basic operations skills, has ridden 1,000 miles, or even licensed riders who want to keep their skills fresh. Skills practiced include U-Turns, swerving, quick stops, and cornering. Successful completion will waive the driving portion of the Oklahoma driving test. Riders may bring a safe, street legal motorcycle.

Students must provide:

- Safe and street legal motorcycle of any cc size with a full tank of gas
- Proof of Liability Insurance at or above: \$25,000 personal injury, \$50,000 injury per occurrence and \$25,000 property damage
- Proof of Ownership or permission to use, and owner's registration.
- Permission for the instructor to conduct a pre-ride safety inspection.
- Protective gear:
 1. Full finger gloves
 2. Over the ankle boots
 3. Long sleeve shirt or jacket
 4. Eye protection
 5. DOT or SNELL approved helmet
